

Personnel Commission
Municipal Code Sections § 32.01 – 32.54

The Personnel Commission of the city shall consist of five members. The term of office for members of the Personnel Commission is for a period of two-years. Commission members are appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the City Council. The Personnel Commission performs the following duties: a) hear disciplinary actions as set forth in the city's personnel rules; and b) such other duties as the Council shall, from time to time, require.

Appointees to the Personnel Commission shall be residents of the City of Baldwin Park at the time of appointment and at all times during their term in office. Additionally, Commission members shall not hold public office as an elected official at the time of their appointment or at any other time during their term. Each member of a Personnel Commission serves at the pleasure of the City Council.

Housing Commission
Municipal Code Sections §32.01 – 32.24

The Housing Commission of the city consists of seven members who are appointed and designated to Commission Office Nos. 1 through 7 respectively. Commissioners Nos. 6 and 7 shall be persons who are tenants of the authority. Commissioner appointed to Office No. 7 shall be over 62 years of age if the authority has tenants of such age. Tenant Commissioners shall have all the powers, duties, and privileges as any other Commissioner. Commission members of Office Nos. 1-5 are appointed to a four-year term. Commission members of Office Nos. 6 and 7 are appointed to a two-year term.

Appointees to the Housing Commission must be residents of the City of Baldwin Park at the time of appointment and at all times during their term in office. Additionally, Commission members shall not hold public office as an elected official at the time of their appointment or at any other time during their term. Each member serves at the pleasure of the City Council.

Recreation & Community Services Commission
Municipal Code Sections §32.01 – 32.38

The Recreation and Community Services Commission of the city consists of seven members, five of who are designated and appointed to Commission Office Nos. 1 through 5 and serve a two-year term respectively. Three members are Student Commission Representatives, serve one-year term and are designated to Commission Office Nos. 6, 7, and 8 respectively, and shall 1) be over the age of 16 years, and less than 19 years of age during their terms of office; 2) one member shall be a student at Baldwin Park High School, the other member shall be a student at Sierra Vista High School, and one member shall be a student at North Park High School at the time of their respective appointments; and 3) No person shall be appointed to Office Nos. 6, 7 or 8 unless the principal of his/her high school has certified his/her eligibility for the appointment. Certification shall only be made after an appropriate selection process has been observed, involving as a part thereof, the wishes of the student body of each high school as to appropriate candidates.

Qualifications: Appointees to the Recreation and Community Services Commission must be residents of the City of Baldwin Park at the time of their appointment and at all times during their term in office. Additionally, Commission members shall not hold public office as an elected official at the time of their appointment or at any other time during their term. Each member of the Commission shall serve at the pleasure of the City Council.

Planning Commission

Municipal Code Sections § 32.01 – 32.68

The Planning Commission of this City consists of a total of five members. Each member of the Planning Commission serves a two-year term. Commission members are appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the City Council. City Planning Commissioners perform the duties required by applicable state law, and such other duties as may be ordered by the City Council.

Qualifications: Appointees to the City of Baldwin Park Commissions shall be residents of the City of Baldwin Park at the time of appointment and at all times during their term in office. Additionally, Commission members shall not hold public office as an elected official at the time of their appointment or at any other time during their term. Each member of the commission shall serve at the pleasure of the City Council.
