Skateboarding and skating are hazardous activities, skate at your own risk. The Skate Park facility is unsupervised. Helmets, knee and elbow pads are required. Failure to wear protective gear will subject persons to a citation. (BPMC 96.25) An adult must accompany children under 14 years of age. No unauthorized pieces of equipment or obstacles allowed in the Skate Park. No smoking, alcohol or drug use allowed. No glass containers of any kind allowed. No spectators permitted in the Skate Park. Skating on park curbs and park sidewalks is prohibited. Profanity, loud music and reckless behavior are not permitted.
