Kaiser Permanente Baldwin Park Medical Center, the Baldwin Park Police Department, and the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) is giving the public a chance to help prevent pill abuse and theft by ridding their homes of potentially dangerous expired, unused, and unwanted medications. On October 26 from 10 AM. to 2 PM, bring your medications for disposal to Kaiser Permanente Baldwin Park Medical Center, 1011 Baldwin Park Blvd., Baldwin Park, CA 91706. A drive-thru service will expedite this goal with added convenience. The service is free and anonymous, no questions asked. Items that will be accepted include controlled substances/prescriptions, non-controlled substances/prescriptions, over-the-counter medications, and veterinary medications (pills and solids only). Items that will not be accepted include liquid waste products, intravenous solutions, injectables, syringes, hazardous or household waste (paint, oil, batteries, etc.)

Un servicio drive-thru (siglas en inglés) acelerará este objetivo en manera conveniente. El servicio es gratuito y anónimo, sin hacer preguntas. 

## About The Project

The City of Baldwin Park has launched a process to develop a Health and Sustainability Element. This policy document is part of the City's General Plan and will provide policy direction for improving community and ecological health in Baldwin Park. Communities across the nation are exploring a variety of initiatives that address community health and sustainability. **Baldwin Park: Growing Healthier, Greener, Stronger** is a sixteen-month process that includes an extensive public involvement campaign. Over the course of the next nine months, a team of City staff and technical consultants will ask for feedback from the community on opportunities to address issues related to health and the built environment, air and water quality, energy conservation, and related topics.

### What is a General Plan?

A general plan is a long-range policy document that identifies goals and policies that address future growth and development in a city. A general plan includes seven mandatory elements: Land Use, Circulation, Housing, Conservation, Open Space, Noise and Safety. Recently, municipalities have been incorporating a new element into their general plans to address community health and sustainability. These elements promote improved community and environmental health, tying goals to decisions related to development.

| <br><b>Bus Rapid Transit on Ramona Boulevard</b><br>Baldwin Park has proposed a Bus Rapid Transit line along Ramona Boulevard for Foothill Transit buses. The bus line will likely link San Dimas to El Monte, and begin service in 2015. The City is also enhancing bus stops along Ramona Boulevard to increase their appeal to transit riders.  | <b>Energy Conservation</b><br>Baldwin Park has implemented many projects to save energy at City facilities, including building audits and upgrades. In collaboration with the San Gabriel Council of Governments, Baldwin Park developed an Energy Efficiency Plan.   | <b>Basic Program</b><br>The City offers a Before and After School Care (BASIC) program at every elementary school in the city. The program provides children with physical activity opportunities, as well as educational activities, rest periods, and healthy food.  |
| <br><b>Transit Oriented Development Specific Plan</b><br>The City is considering an application for development of 71 affordable residential units in the heart of Downtown, adjacent to City Hall and the Transit Station. The development will also include commercial and restaurant space.   | <b>Bikeways along Walnut Creek Wash and Ramona Boulevard</b><br>The San Gabriel Commuter Bikeway is planned for construction along Walnut Creek Wash. Access to Baldwin Park will be through the Walnut Creek Nature Center, and possibly a major employment center along Baldwin Park Boulevard.   | <b>Parks Master Plan Completed</b><br>The Baldwin Park Comprehensive Park and Recreation Plan, completed in 2005, establishes a community-supported road map for providing high-quality, well-managed parks and recreation facilities throughout the community.  |
| <br><b>2012 Zoning Code</b><br>The Zoning Code allows for mixed-use development of integrated retail, office, and residential uses in the City's downtown area and along selected corridors.  | <b>Regional Bike Master Plan</b><br>Baldwin Park is participating in a regional bike master planning initiative led by the San Gabriel Bike Coalition.  | <b>Active Parks</b><br>Baldwin Park has installed fitness equipment in public parks, which are free for use. Exercise facilities and classes are also available at the Community Center.   |
| <br><b>Complete Streets Policy</b><br>Baldwin Park passed a Complete Streets Policy in 2011 that is designed to make streets safer and more accessible for all users, including bicyclists, pedestrians, and transit users.  | <b>Safe Routes to School Plan</b><br>Baldwin Park initiated a Safe Routes to School (SRTS) program in mid-2012, with funding provided by Caltrans. SRTS programs seek to improve the health and well-being of children by enabling and encouraging them to walk or bike to school.  | <b>Teen Center</b><br>The Teen Center offers teens a fun, active place to spend time. The Center features a healthy kitchen, active family game room, rock climbing wall, and skate park.  |
| <br><b>Living Streets Manual Draft</b><br>This exhaustive manual is designed to assist and guide the City in redeveloping current streetscapes into multi-functional, lively, and enjoyable public spaces.   | <b>Sidewalk Retrofits</b><br>The Department of Public Works has initiated a sidewalk replacement project to make new sidewalks more resistant to damage by street trees and thus safer for pedestrians.   | <b>Joint Use Agreement with School District</b><br>The City has a joint use agreement with the Baldwin Park Unified School District to use the fields at the Olive, Mantis, Sierra Vista, and Baldwin Park Elementary Schools. These fields provide additional open and recreational space for all community members.  |
| <br><b>Transit Center</b><br>The Transit Center next to City Hall consists of a five-level parking structure and provides access to many transit lines, as well as an overhead pedestrian bridge to the Metrolink Station.   | <br><b>Superfund Cleanup</b><br>Baldwin Park is located in the San Gabriel Valley Basin, where groundwater was contaminated through improper chemical handling and disposal by industries making rocket fuel and solvents. The City continues to work closely with the EPA to clean up the site and provide clean drinking water to Baldwin Park residents.    | <br><b>Reduction of Tobacco and No Smoking Policies</b><br>The City has sought to limit residents' exposure to second-hand smoke by limiting smoking areas. Also, all facilities that sell tobacco are locally licensed and regulated.  |
| <br><b>Nonmotorized Transportation Effort</b><br>The City is working on a focused plan within the Pacific, Ramona, and Downey triangle to provide better linkages throughout Downtown to Metrolink and the Transit Center.   | <br><b>Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, and Compost</b><br>The local food oils recycling program provides for collection of fats, oils, and greases from restaurants and food processors free of charge. The City contracts with Waste Management for trash collection at residential and nonresidential properties. Expanded recycling programs are under development. | <br><b>Urban Forest Program</b><br>Baldwin Park plans to update the City Street Trees plan to address current needs and best practices. In the meantime, the City has obtained funding from the Valley County Water District and Air Quality Management District to plant street trees.                                     |
| <br><b>Senior Lunch Program</b><br>The Baldwin Park Senior Center provides hot meals sponsored by Intervale Senior Services. The YWCA Intervale Senior Services offers well-balanced meals at no cost to local seniors.  | <br><b>HEAL Food Procurement Project</b><br>In 2013, Baldwin Park received a Healthy Eating Active Living Grant for a food procurement project. Baldwin Park and its partners will develop a citywide healthy food corner market incentive program, piloted in three to five markets.  | <br><b>Healthy Eating, Active Communities</b><br>Healthy Eating, Active Communities (HEAC) was a four-year strategic initiative funded by the California Endowment to reduce disparities in obesity and diabetes by improving food and physical activity environments for school-aged children in low-income neighborhoods. |
| <br><b>Healthy Selections Program</b><br>Local residents and teens from are improving healthy food selections in Baldwin Park corner stores. The effort led by the HEAC initiative seeks to reduce marketing of unhealthy foods and beverages in Baldwin Park and to increase healthy food and beverage offerings in corner stores near schools. | <br><b>Breast Feeding Policy</b><br>The City has adopted an organization-wide policy of supporting breastfeeding and having City facilities be breastfeeding-friendly workplaces.  | <br><b>Senior Lunch Program</b><br>The Baldwin Park Senior Center provides hot meals sponsored by Intervale Senior Services. The YWCA Intervale Senior Services offers well-balanced meals at no cost to local seniors.   |
